

Getting to Wagon Trail Campground

From Chicago take I-94 to Milwaukee, then I-43 north towards Green Bay.

Alternate routes to Door County include:

- Route #1: Head on I-43 all the way to Green Bay then take Hwy. 57 north to Sturgeon Bay
- Route #2: Just north of Manitowoc take Hwy. 310 (Two Rivers) East to Hwy. 42, follow 42 North to Sturgeon Bay.


From Minnesota and Twin Cities take I-94 to Hwy. 29 (just beyond Menomonie, WI); 29 will take you to Green Bay. Take 41 north briefly, then I-43 South briefly to 57; exit going east into Door County (follow Sturgeon Bay signs).

South of Sturgeon Bay, Hwys 42 & 57 join, then bypass the city and separate on the north side. Hwy. 42 then goes up the bay side of the peninsula (west side) and Hwy. 57 goes up the lake side (east side). They both meet back up again in Sister Bay. One short block north of where 57 terminates at 42, take a right onto County Road ZZ. There is an Ace Hardware store on the right hand corner at the turn. You will be heading down a hill towards downtown Sister Bay when you turn onto ZZ.

Follow ZZ east out of town for 6 miles to reach us. County Road ZZ does zig zag. It takes a big 90 degree turn to the north 2-3 miles out of town and then another big 90 degree turn back east in another 2-3 miles. Stay on the main road and slow down for the curves. As you get close you'll cross over Mink River Road. Shortly after you will see a sign to reduce your speed to 35 mph. Slow down and you'll see our sign on the left.

Alternate Route: If you are towing we feel it is an easier drive coming up on the lake side of the peninsula via Hwy. 57. Just north of Baileys Harbor you will pass Hwy. Q. Continue on 57 for about another 6 miles until you pass Hwy. Q a second time. Continue on 57 for another 1/2 mile past Q to the next intersection which is Olde Stage Road. Turn right onto Olde Stage Road follow it for 3.5 miles to a stop sign. This is County Road ZZ. Turn right onto ZZ and follow the directions above regarding ZZ. This route bypasses Sister Bay.
